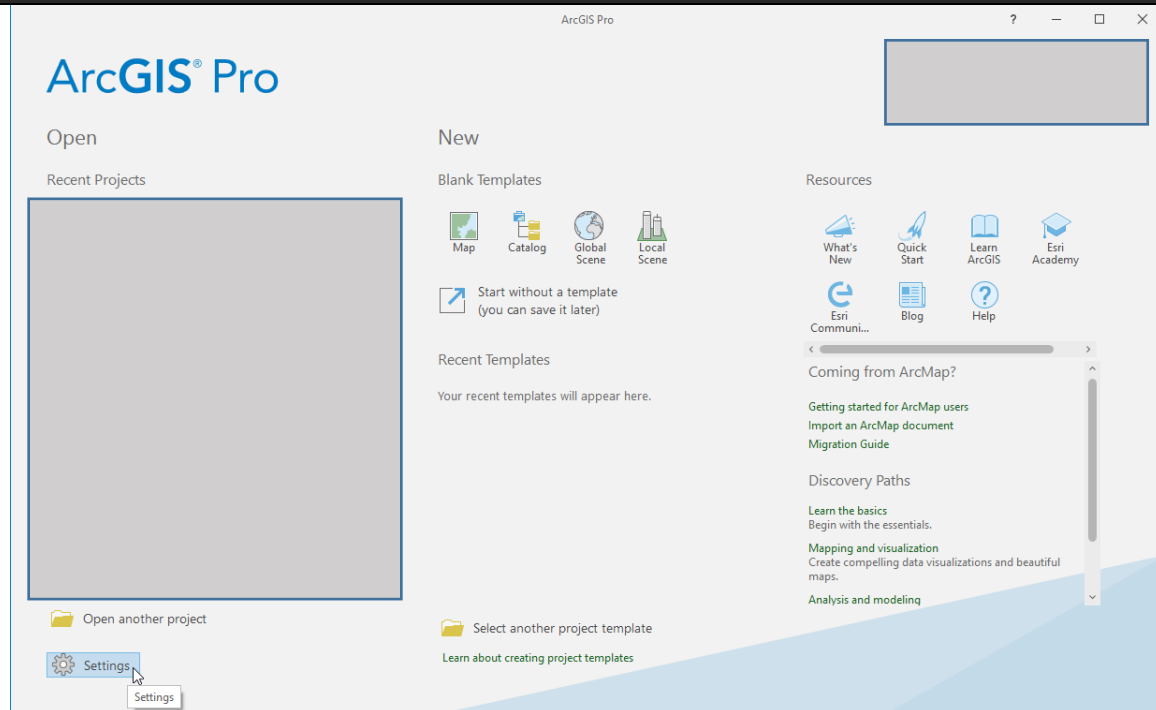

Steps to authenticate your ArcGIS Pro software

1. Launch ArcGIS Pro, click on Settings on the bottom-left.

Note that if this is the first time you are authenticating your ArcGIS Pro software, you can skip to step 5 of this guide.



2. Click on the Licensing tab on the menu, then on “Configure your licensing options” at the bottom.

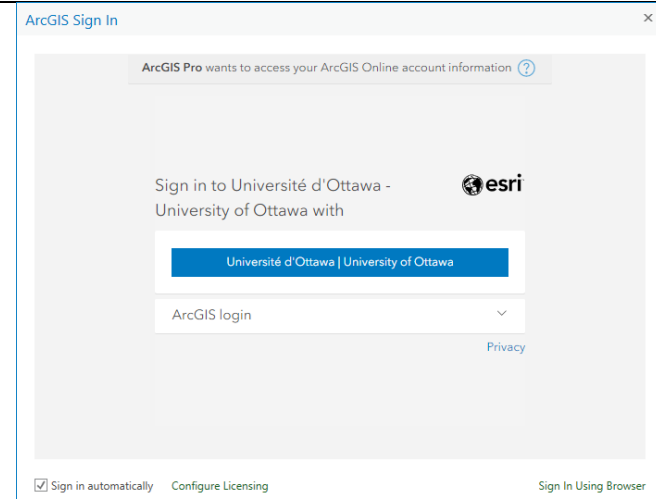
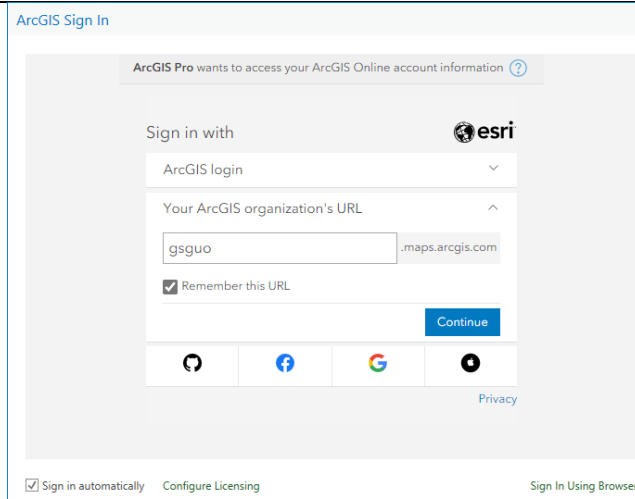
4. You will now need to shut down ArcGIS Pro for the license changes to take effect.




5. Start up your ArcGIS Pro again. You now need to login to ArcGIS Pro to complete the authentication process. Click on the "Your ArcGIS organization's URL" option at the bottom.



6. Enter "gsguo" in the "Your ArcGIS organization's URL". You can also check off the "Remember this URL". Click Continue. In the next window, click on the **Université d'Ottawa | University of Ottawa** blue button that appears at the top.



<p>7. Sign in using your single sign on credentials (same as your uoZone/uoAccess). Your username should be your full uOttawa email address. Click Next and enter your uoZone/uoAccess password.</p>	
<p>8. Your ArcGIS Pro license should now be authenticated, and you can now use ArcGIS Pro. Happy mapping!</p>
